



5 RARE & INCOMPARABLE ROADSIDE STOPS

For those who like to mix a little of the odd, unusual or one-of-a-kind into to their traveling plans, add these stops to your Yakima Valley road trip.



TREASURES IN THE TOWN OF TIETON

Tiny pieces of hand-cut glass come together in the hands of Tieton Mosaic's artists to form murals and other art installations. Take the short drive to **Tieton** to **tour public art mosaics**, typographic mosaics, artful signage and even mosaic reproductions of vintage fruit labels, a nod to the Yakima Valley's agricultural roots.



A TEAPOT WITH A STORY TO TELL

Zillah's Teapot Dome Service Station was hand-built in 1922 as commentary to a Harding Administration political scandal of the same name. Roughly 13 feet tall, complete with handle and spout, it now serves as a **visitor center and world-famous selfie stop**.



A NEON GARDEN A-GLOW

Like many places, at one time, glowing neon signs graced the streets of Yakima. Once an almost lost art form, neon now enjoys a bit of a resurgence but remains rare. For fans of the art, **Yakima Valley Museum** gives new life to nearly a dozen of Yakima's original, vintage neon signs in their hanging gallery, **The Neon Garden**.



THE BAT CAVE AT DEVIL CREEK

Formed through erosion of ancient lava flows, **Boulder Cave** is home to Pacific Western big-eared bats. The cave extends about 400 feet and runs alongside Devil Creek. The bats are a sensitive species in WA and OR. Follow posted precautions to protect them. A timed reservation system is enforced.



TOUR THE HISTORIC MURALS

Find out why Toppenish was named "**One of the Prettiest Painted Places**" in the United States. Visit each of the more than **75 Toppenish Murals** and take a self-guided tour through the history of the area. Take in the sights of Native American life and culture, wild west adventures and early-American ingenuity.

A short drive from downtown Yakima takes you to Naches Heights, a small, dynamic AVA atop a volcanic plateau. Reserve exclusive vineyard tours and private pours with the winemaker at **Naches Heights Vineyard**. Sample more of their exceptional wines, along with other hand-picked pours and small plates in the picturesque setting of nearby **DoodleVines Winery & Event Center** wine bar. Sample biodynamically grown wines and spirits at **Wilridge Vineyard, Winery & Distillery** perched above the dramatic landscape of Cowiche Canyon. Make time for a canyon hike and vineyard

walk! Nearby **Rider Cellars** welcomes visitors to their charming tasting room for tastings that include varietals less commonly found in the Yakima Valley.

In the heart of downtown Yakima, enjoy live music every weekend at the vibrant **Kana Winery**. Linger in the cozy tasting room or on the patio at **AntoLin Cellars** and enjoy luscious wines sourced from their AntoLin Estate Vineyard. RATTLESNAKE HILLS WINE TRAIL

Just 15 minutes from downtown Yakima, the Rattlesnake Hills AVA is one of Washington State's most fertile grape growing regions. This unique area boasts ridgetop vineyards at more than 3,000 feet in elevation, higher in general than the Yakima Valley AVA overall. With 1,800 vine acres and two dozen wineries, this region specializes in cabernet franc, cabernet sauvignon, merlot, syrah, chardonnay and riesling.

The area's wineries showcase distinctive, award-winning wines in picturesque settings surrounded by beautiful orchards, stunning views and acres of vineyards. With just minutes between each winery, it's easy to plan a weekend tasting tour. Come roam The Hills, whether by bus, car, bicycle or horse.

Most wineries in the Rattlesnake Hills area are family owned and operated, producing their wines from the ground up, from farm to glass. Unlike some larger wine destinations, here you

can stroll through the vines with the growers and winemakers themselves, getting a first-hand perspective on how they make their wines. Each winery has a uniquely crafted tasting room, from Northwest modern architecture to traditional European and everything in between. Many of them have picnic areas perfect for a relaxing snack or lunch in the sun. Check winery websites and social channels for local food options available for purchase. Don't forget to ask questions! These winemakers love to share their wines and tell their stories.

If you're looking for a truly unique experience, be sure to visit Rattlesnake Hills during one of the Yakima Valley's signature event weekends (page 9) throughout the year. Many of the wineries offer something special during these weekend celebrations. Be sure to follow the wineries' social channels for winery events and experiences, food offerings and wine releases and promotions.







- Hops are the flowering cones of a climbing plant (called bines) that are used in the beer brewing process. Hops create unique flavors and aromas in beer and bring balance to the sweetness of malts.
- The Yakima Valley has the ideal combination of climate, day length, soil and access to irrigation systems for hop growing, making it the largest hop growing region in the United States.
- The U.S. produces more hops than any other country (including Germany). Washington State accounts for more than 70% of that, virtually all of that coming from the Yakima Valley.

TOP TRAILS FOR SPRING/SUMMER HIKING & BIKING

Explore trails year-round, ranging from the rolling grass and sage-covered plains and hills of the shrub-steppe to dramatic, volcanic formations, subalpine meadows, forested terrain and more. Keep your eyes open for bighorn sheep, elk, raptors and other wildlife.



SPRINGTIME WILDFLOWER HIKES

Enjoy the most blooms from mid-April until late May or early June, with dense carpets of flowers in every color, from bright yellows and shades of orange to a multitude of purples and pinks. Most common wildflowers include balsamroot, lupine, larkspur, purple bitterroot, big head clover, phlox and violets.

- **Snow Mountain Ranch in the Cowiche Canyon Conservancy Trail System** delivers dramatic valley and mountain views.
- **Yakima Skyline Trail** climbs to traverse the rim of the stunning Yakima River Canyon below.
- **Umtanum Creek Trail to Umtanum Ridge** travels through grassy slopes, aspen and willow groves, a dramatic canyon and peaceful meadows.



SUMMER'S PERFECT PICNIC SPOTS

On the Yakima Valley's hot, sunny summer days, begin your hikes and bike rides early in the day and choose trails with shady, picturesque picnic spots.

- **Cowiche Canyon Conservancy East Trail/Winery Hike** winds along Cowiche Creek through the canyon to the winery hike detour. Stroll through the vineyards and then picnic on the grassy lawn of Wilridge Vineyard, Winery & Distillery.
- **Boulder Cave Trail** offers a short, easy hike to the 400-foot-deep Boulder Cave, home to a fragile big-eared bat colony. Picnic at the covered day use area and enjoy the Naches River. *Timed Reservation System*
- **Cleman Mountain/Waterworks Canyon** features two hike options and plenty of picnic spots with valley views.

YAKIMA VALLEY WATERWAYS FISH, FLOAT & PADDLE

With the Yakima Valley's reliably sunny skies come summertime highs. Six rivers and dozens of lakes and ponds all around the Yakima Valley mean you'll find plenty of places to keep cool, whether fishing, floating, boating or paddling is your preference.

MOUNTAIN LAKES

Take the short drive from Yakima along Highway 12 or Highway 410 for adventures on pristine mountain lakes with picture-perfect views.

- **Rimrock Lake's** expansive, clear blue waters are easily explored by SUP, kayak or boat. Anglers find kokanee and rainbow trout in the cool waters.
- **Clear Lake** is a much smaller, peaceful lake for only non-motorized craft, perfect for learning SUP. Pack a picnic for the day use area. Fishing is open year-round.
- **Bumping Lake** is perfect for a day-long excursion from Yakima. It's a popular place for boating, fishing and paddling, along with trails for hiking, biking and horseback riding.

YAKIMA RIVER





CITY OF TIETON

The tiny town of Tieton packs a lot into a few square blocks around a charming park in the middle of it all. Tieton has become a magnet for art lovers, artisans and adventure seekers. Perched at the very top of the Yakima Valley, this quaint community of 2,000 was established in 1888 and grew as one of the foremost apple growing regions in the Yakima Valley.

Then, 20 years ago, **Mighty Tieton** was born. This artisan business incubator is home to extraordinary arts installations, such as the acclaimed **Trimpin Sound Space** and hosts some of the most unusual events in the Yakima Valley. **Tieton Mosaic** creates public art murals around the country and has created a bold visual identity for the town through the Vintage Project, which recreated the bold typographic Yakima Valley fruit crate label designs from the early to mid-1900s. Nomad Kitchen has quickly established itself as a superb farm-to-table restaurant with a menu that changes with the seasons. Adjoining is **Nomad-Mercantile**, a must-stop for goods for your outdoor adventures, from camping to foraging. It's also your source for Yakima Valley wines and wine touring information. The **Tieton Cabin Company** constructs hand built cabins that are ready made to go anywhere to become the

guest accommodations at your camp destination, the income property in your backyard, or your personal retreat in the wilderness. Tietoncabinco.com





Nestled against the foothills of the Cascade Mountains, the Town of Naches owes its name to the river that flows through it and to the indigenous peoples who historically traveled through the Naches Valley to reach the coast, to fish from area rivers or to pick huckleberries in the mountains. They called the river winding through the valley “Natchez,” meaning turbulent water. It wasn’t until 1908 that U.S. postal authorities changed the name to Naches.

Today, that river and the rugged mountains still play a vital role in the community thought of as the Gateway to the Cascades. As rolling, orchard-covered hillsides give way to the beginning of forested slopes, you reach what locals refer to as “the Y,” the intersection of Hwy 12 and SR 410, leading to the **White Pass and Chinook Pass Scenic Byways** (pg. 38). Both deliver endless adventures on rivers, mountain lakes and trails.

Begin your day with a stop at **Cot’s Peak Coffee**, named for the tallest peak on nearby Cleman Mountain. The cozy coffeehouse and gathering place serves

up locally roasted coffee and homemade bagels. After a day in the mountains, raise a glass in the historic charm of **Van’s 1885 Bar & Grill**. The 1921 building is one of the oldest in town and the bar itself was crafted in 1885 on the east coast. Or, stop by **D’Nile Tap House** for great food and mountain town charm. **What I Crave Restaurant and Tavern** is a new addition after years as a popular food truck.

On the other end of the town, visitors are greeted by a collection of fruit stands reflecting the agricultural roots of the community. Stop by **Naches Trading Post** for fresh, local produce, or **Thompson’s Farm Market** for fruit grown on the

multigenerational farm, along with local artisan food products and gifts. Find pieces from local makers at **Lakat Gallery**.

For those seeking historical highlights, the distinctive **Art Deco Building**, complete with a tall spire and neon trim, has been a Naches landmark since 1935. The restored **1906 Train Depot** is now home to many of the Town’s events and an excellent starting point for this bike-friendly town. The **Naches Bandstand**, built in 1919, stands in its original location and is a centerpiece of the town’s **Sportsman’s Days**.







In September, the skies fill with colorful hot air balloons as they take flight at the **Great Prosser Balloon Rally**. Afterwards the downtown streets fill with artisans and crafters during the **Harvest Festival**. In November, get ready for the holidays by joining us for **Bubbles & Bites**. Come sample the sparkling wines Prosser has to offer and take some home for those holiday gatherings.




